

Commercial Fire Service line charges promulgated in 2010

The Evergreen Metropolitan District Board of Directors has voted to reinstate the monthly service charge for fire service lines beginning in January 2010.

The District's operations staff is being required to spend additional time and attention to all maintenance issues on the water distribution due to the use of large fire service lines supplying sprinklers in commercial buildings within the District.

There are no tap fees associated with a fire service nor is the water itself metered when used; however there are a number of water system requirements that are necessary to maintain the water system in order to not negatively affect the growing number of commercial fire service lines in the District.

Therefore the Board has decided to again promulgate a monthly fire service charge based on the fire service line size into the building.

8 inch line = \$ 8.00 / month

6 inch line = \$ 6.00 / month

4 inch line = \$ 4.00 / month

2 inch line = \$ 2.00 / month
